PROGRAM AND ACTIVITIES

The following information will give you a good overview of the program and activities.

PLAZA

The InterJamboree-Plaza is a large place, where you can find several interesting things. There will be various activities to do such as rope knotting, T-shirt screen printing, pyro engraving, etc.

The Dutch scout shop will offer typical scout equipment, badges, and other stuff and you can visit a Scout Museum.

Bring your own T-shirt to be screen printed! (cotton is preferred) There will be no screen printing on uniforms!

SCOUTSCLUB



SCOUTERS CLUB 18+



A special (and magical) place for 18+ only! Let's all meet there, catch a breath, listen to some music and chat. This is a space just for you, where you can meet scouts from other countries, share your stories and interests. Only open at the times indicated.

ONSITE ACTIVITIES – on Saturday

You will participate in activities and games which will be located on the Sports fields Plaza and the whole campsite. All in the theme "Fast and Magical"

You will be connected with mixed international groups, so you can get an international experience.

For one game you need 4 milk carton caps! For another game you need an empty soda bottle! Bring these from home.

SERVING THE COMMUNITY

Every troop will during the Hike take part in service for the community so we can "Try and leave this world a little better than you found it" as B-P once said. Each participant has already made preparations for this on Friday or Saturday at the plaza.

HIKE - on Sunday

Each troop will go on hike experience. (in mixed international groups of app. 8-10 participants). It's going to be a tough hike!. During the walk, participants discover the beauty of the area around Sittard-Geleen.



For the hike it is important to bring a canteen filled with water, a bag lunch, Personal ID, raingear and head gear if needed, first aid kit and sun screen. Also remember to bring good walking shoes!

SUBCAMP INFORMATION

There are 2 subcamps during the InterJamboree.

On subcamp 1 are the blue and yellow participants; on Subcamp 2 are the red and green participants.

Why the participants are divided into these colored groups, we will let you know during the InterJamboree.





Your camping spot may be 10m2 per participant. Adjust your camping equipment and other materials accordingly.

- Subcamps will not be lighted, we recommend to take a flashlight with you.
- The Subcamp team has radio connection to the First Aid station.
- The use of electronic sound equipment is prohibited. So no bluetooth speakers or such.
- You must bring your own fire extinguisher for each cooking point!
- You must take your waste home with you after the InterJamboree.
- Your campsite is to be cleaned thoroughly before leaving, this must be confirmed by the Subcamp team.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- The official language of the event is English.
- All participants will receive a bracelet/strap in a specific color. With the help of these colors we know the function and/or age of the participants. This bracelet may not be damaged and must be worn visibly on your wrist during the entire event.
- You can only pay in cash with EUR.
- The organization of the InterJamboree will not pay costs of medical examinations for participants or IST-ers.
- We expect everyone in uniform for the Opening and Closing ceremonies and of course during the hike. (And other times when you are away from the camp site.)
- The instructions of the staff are to be followed.
 All final decisions rest with the camp organization. (They can be recognized by an orange neckerchief.)



ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

On arrival at the camp please **register your group on the Subcamp** site. Please bring your registration confirmation and participants list with you.

On the day of departure you can also **unsubscribe your group** at the Subcamp site.

FIRST AID STATION

The First Aid station is located on the side of the sports club building towards the podium, it will be marked with a prominent sign. All injuries, even minor ones treated in the campsite, must be brought to the First Aid station personnel for treatment and/or recording. The Subcamp team has radio connection to the First Aid station.

DAILY INFORMATION



Daily information can be found on the notice boards.

LISTENING EAR

If you want to talk to someone about things during the camp that you want to get off your chest, but you don't really know what to do with it, we have a listening ear at the camp. Ask the camp organization or the First Aid team to put you in touch with this person.

IST / INFO TENT

The IST / INFO tent is an information point near the Plaza area Participants and IST members can contact us here for questions regarding the camp events and the program.

This is also the point where Lost and Found items can be reported.
